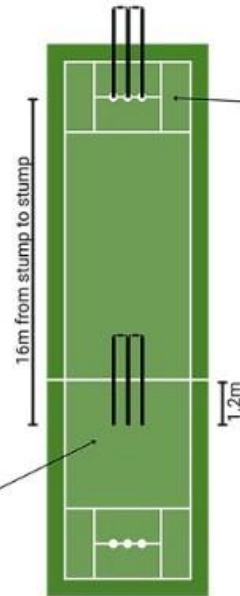


# Setting up the Ground – Stage 1

You will need:

- ☐ 1 set of wooden stumps (with bails)
- ☐ 1 set of plastic stumps (with bails)
- ☐ Chalk or tape to mark the crease
- ☐ A tape measure

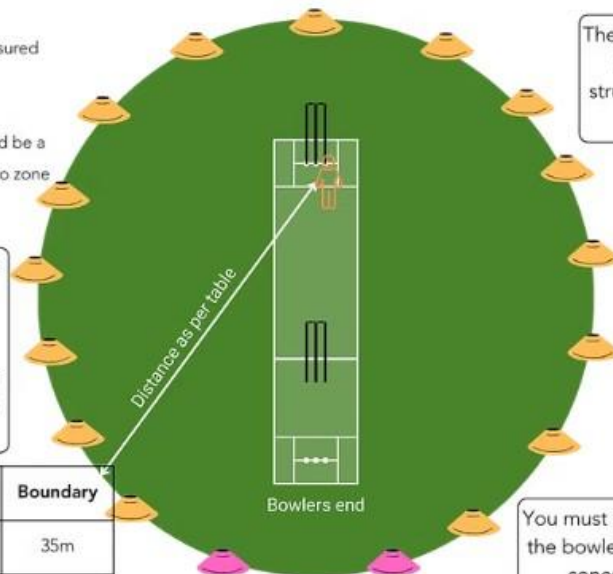


In the pre-existing stump holes at one end, set up your set of wooden stumps and bails. This is the end that both teams will bat from.

16m from the wooden stumps, set up the plastic stumps and bails. You will also need to mark the crease 1.2m in front of the stumps with chalk or tape.

You will need:

- ☐ A tape measure or pre-measured string
- ☐ Minimum of plastic cones
- ☐ \*A couple of those 25 should be a different colour for the no-go zone



The boundary should be at least 3 metres away from any solid structure or scorers tent, player's tent or spectators.

Get someone to stand at the batting crease and hold the other end of the tape measure. Then walk around the field in a circle, putting a cone down around every 10 to 15 steps

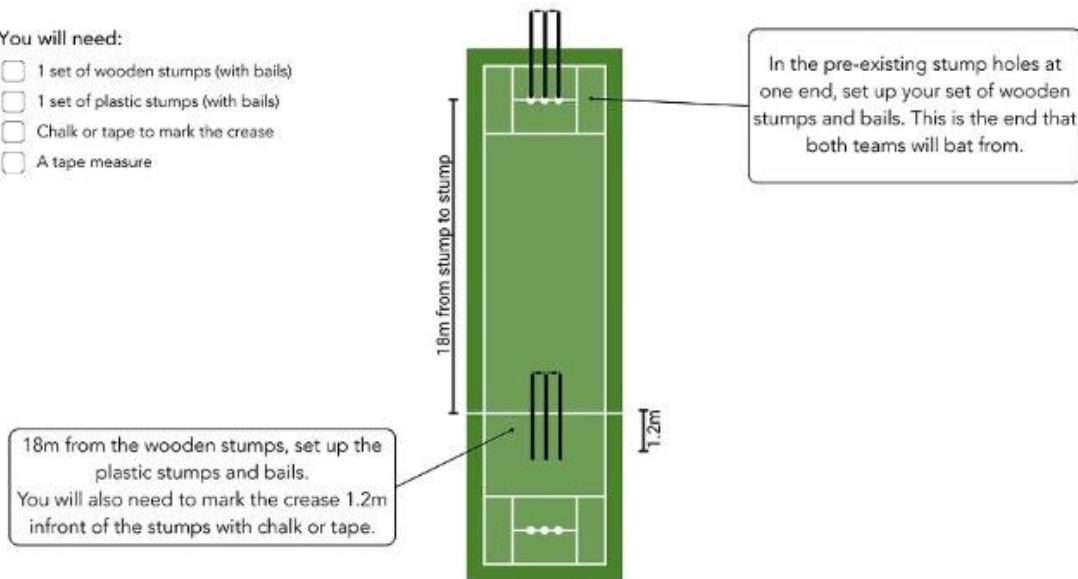
| Age Group                      | Boundary |
|--------------------------------|----------|
| Year 4 Boys and Year 4-5 Girls | 35m      |
| Year 5 Boys and Year 6-7 Girls | 40m      |

You must include a "no-go" zone behind the bowlers end, with different coloured cones where spectators are not permitted to stand.

## Setting up the Ground – Stage 2

You will need:

- ☐ 1 set of wooden stumps (with bails)
- ☐ 1 set of plastic stumps (with bails)

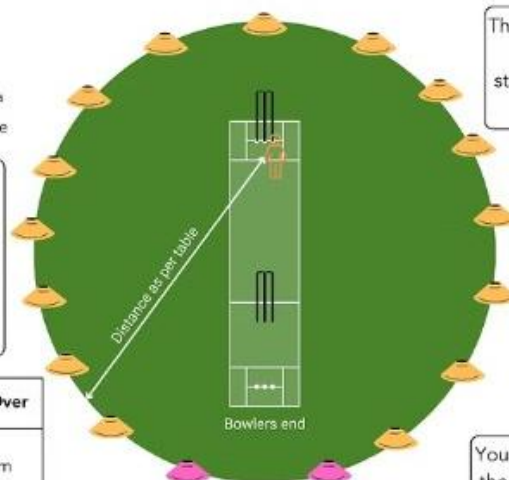

|--------------------------------|-----|---------|
| Year 6 Boys and Year 8-9 Girls | 40m | 45m     |
| Year 7 Boys                    | 40m | 50m     |

You must include a "no-go" zone behind the bowlers end, with different coloured cones where spectators are not permitted to stand.

## Setting up the Ground – Stage 3

In Stage 3 cricket, the pitch is full sized, so you don't have to measure the smaller size.

Make sure you have two sets of wooden stumps with bails to put at both ends of the pitch.

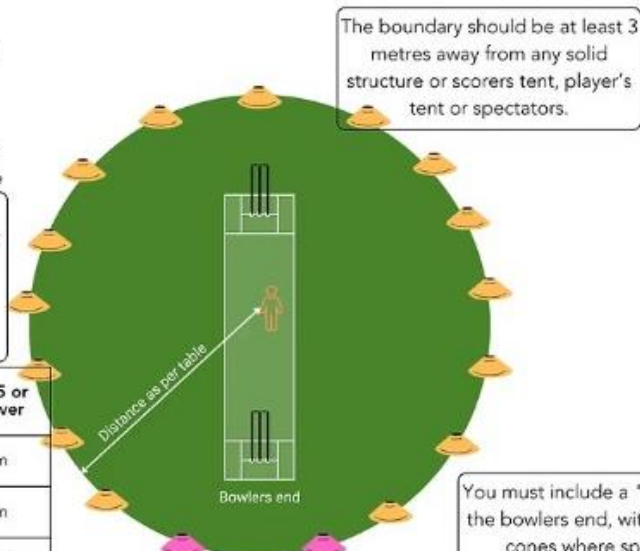


### You will need:

- ☐ A tape measure or pre-measured string
- ☐ Minimum of plastic cones
- ☐ \*A couple of those 25 should be a different colour for the no-go zone

Get someone to stand in the middle of the pitch and hold the other end of the tape measure. Then walk around the field in a circle, putting a cone down around every 10 to 15 steps

| Age Group           | T20 | 30, 35 or 40 Over |
|---------------------|-----|-------------------|
| Year 8 Boys         | 45m | 50m               |
| Year 9 Boys         | 50m | 55m               |
| Year 10-11 Boys     | 50m | 60m               |
| Year 10-11-12 Girls | 45m | 45m               |
